THIS IS NOT YOUR ORDINARY WINE LIST.

We are mixing things up and are trying to make it easier for you to understand and choose the right wine for the mood you are in right now. We have a lot of categories that sometimes need an explanation, and here it is.

THE PICTURES OF EX. LEMON: There are no lemons in the wine, but it's one of the flavors that the grape smells or tastes like. So do not worry, there is no butter in your wine.

G/L: It indicates the sugar level in the wines. For instance, a dry wine contains between 2-3 grams of sugar per liter while 22 g/l is a semi-sweet wine.

0 MG/L SO₂: It indicates the sulphite level in the wines, which is important for natural wine enthusiasts. If a white wine has below 40 mg/l SO₂ and a red wine has 30 mg/l SO₂, you can call them natural wines.

HVE: (Haute Valeur Environnementale) is a sustainable label used in France, where they work with organic principles.

ECO: As you know it from Milk and Eggs.

OAK: Many wines are stored in oak barrels. Some of the benefits include a soft maturation of the wines and the addition of flavours like vanilla, chocolate, coconut or baking spices.

OXI: Intentionally matured with controlled oxygen influence over time to develop complex, nutty, savory, and caramelized character without becoming oxidized.

HAUTBOIS - MONTAGNE DE REIMS - PÉVY

Hautbois is a 5th generation Champagne producer in the village of Pévy, in the Massif de Saint-Thierry near Reims. Run today by Sandrine and Fabien Hautbois. Focusing on the blue grapes, especially Pinot Meunier. Their Champagne comes with notes of red apples, brioche and touches of vanilla.

VINCENT COUCHE - CÔTE DES BAR

Vincent Couche, grower and biodynamic Champagne producer, certified since 2008. Every step, from vineyard to cellar, is handled in house. Elegance Cuvée is made from 73% Pinot Noir and 27% Chardonnay. With indigenous yeast fermentation followed by 5 years on the lees in oak. This creates a textured and complex Champagne where the terroir is allowed to shine through.

Granddaughter Marie Doyard took over in 2004 and started producing Champagne in house. She is successfully running the estate with four methods: vinification primarily in oak barrels, extended aging (min. 5 years), low extra brut dosage and no malolactic fermentation. Working only with Chardonnay from the prestigious Grand Cru village of Le Mesnil-sur-Oger and Premier Cru village Vertus. The champagne keeps exceptional freshness, balanced by creamy richness, clean minerality, complexity and highly elegant.

From pale and crunchy Provence to rich and fruity Pfalz, rosé is not one style but many. When making rose, it starts with the grapes being gently crushed and the juice is left to macerate with the skins for anywhere between two and twenty hours, depending on style and colour. Once the winemaker is satisfied, the juice is separated from the skins and fermented much like a white wine. With this being said, a magnum is usually a great start for the rose explorer.

Domaine Laroche dates back to 1850 and is still today a leading producer in Chablis. The Domaine is certified with the French HVE certification and is working biodynamic on their Grand Crus. Their wines have pronounced minerality, great balance with big complexity and concentration.

Domaine Jean Féry was founded in 1922 in the heart of Burgundy. Located in Échevronne, where the Côte de Beaune meets the Côte de Nuits. Certified organic since 2011, they cover 33 hectares and work across 37 different appellations. They usually use around 25–30% new French oak depending on the vintage and appellation, giving the wine complexity and body.

The brothers Pierre and Jacques represent the third generation, bringing energy and terroir focused values with a vision that blends tradition and innovation. The riesling shows sharpness, pronounced minerality and zesty citrus. Since they took over they have been experimenting with maceration, and their orange really shines with notes of candied orange and quince.

LOIRE

The Loire valley, being France's longest river and with great climate differences, follows away from the Atlantic Ocean through the inlands and to the east. One thing is certain, when it comes to the white wines, it's all about Chenin Blanc and Sauvignon Blanc with two things in common - minerality & high acidity.

ANTOINE DE LA FARGE - MENETOU SALON

Antoine de la Farges comes from deep roots in east Loire, more precisely in Menetou Salon. Grandfather Clément co-founded the Menetou Salon appellation in 1959. Here it's all about the terroirs' different expressions of Sauvignon Blanc. Menetou Salon has the lightest structure with notes of elderflower and grass. The Pouilly Fumé showing more body with hints of smoke, citrus fruit and flint. The Sancerre with silky texture, clean minerality and notes of gooseberry and white peach.

The wines are clean, concentrated and fresh with the true expression of the Jura appellations tradition. Côtes de Jura Tradition and Château Chalon Vin Jaune matures under floor yeast, where the Vin Jaune spends 6 years and 3 months developing notes of toasted walnuts, bruised apple, salt brine and dried citrus. Oxidative but never oxidised.

Aromatic, intense and complex with notes of quince, white peach and pear, white florals like jasmine and honeysuckle showing mineralic hints of flint and salt with a long silky finish. The wine will age beautifully for the next 25 years but wow, it's good now.

Living Soils, Living Vineyards, Living Wines, is the motto at Tenuta Fornace.

Fumetto made from Pinot Grigio, cold macerated in steel tanks for 6 days with skin contact and refined for a few months on the lees, always in steel. Crunchy apple, flowers and infused herbs.

Tuttosole made from Malvasia and Moscato Bianco grapes. The wine spends 75 days in steel tanks with skin contact. The long maceration gives the wine a serious structure, balanced by fruit concentration and notes of ripe mandarin, orange peel, rooibos tea with a sharp acidity and grippy tannins.

SICILY - ETNA

The wines from Sicily are represented in very different expressions. Sicily with all the sun and Etna as a counterpart being one of the world's most active volcanoes. Where the indigenous grape varieties completely loves the volcanic soil and the windy cooler nights up on high altitudes. Carricante has fresh acidity, notes of ripe white peach, slightly herbaceous and floral with an intense minerality. The Fiano is a fullbodied white with hints of peach, honey and citrus, whereas the Vermentino is full of rosemary, white flowers and a bit salty.

TERRA DE ASOREI - RIAS BAIXAS

If Albariño has a happy place, it's probably Val do Salnés in Rías Baixas. The cool Atlantic influence with wind and fog slows down the grapes ripening, which allows the grape to preserve its natural high acidity and to develop its rich flavors. Mouth watering with floral notes, salty minerality and juicy nectarines. Terra de Asorei makes three different expressions, Cuveé Asorei being crisp, fresh and fruity, Sobre Lias with more texture, after spending 6 months on the lees and Barrica, being the most bodied one with 6 months on oak. We honestly can't pick a favorite!

Priorat is all about high-altitude, with both power and finesse, where Garnacha and Carignan thrive and produce wonderful wines. The family owned winery was founded in 1880 and is now run by the fifth generation. NATURAL WINE

MINIMAL INTERVENTION

Very controversial, and for some, a completely enigma.
But what exactly is natural wine, and what can you expect from it?

In short, natural wines are made with minimal intervention, allowing the grapes and the place to speak for themselves. The vineyards are farmed organically, without the use of pesticides, and nothing is added during production, no cultured yeast, sugar or acid. The wines are typically unfiltered, and sulphite levels are kept very low: generally below 30 mg/l for red wines and 40 mg/l for whites.

That said, there is currently no official legal definition of natural wine, making it something of an uncharted territory. So, what does natural wine actually taste like?

Our natural wines are far from being wild or unpredictable. They don't taste like sour cider, nor do they smell like an old gym bag.

Instead, they are crafted with great care and attention, resulting in wines that feel honest, transparent and full of energy. Wines that express their origin with clarity and character, where the wine making method doesn't overshadow the grape or the place it comes from.

Now what is that orange wine?

Another reach for the 'wine sky', even though the people of Georgia have been making wine this way for the last 5000 years. All of the green grapes are fermented together, including skin, juice and seeds. It is the skin of the grape that gives the wine a darker colour than usual and gives the wine bitterness.

The wine takes on an orange hue, and has more body and tannins.

The taste is dry, and towards orange peel, quince and dried apricots.
